GUIDELINES FOR ELLISON DIE PRESS

- ◆ Please check in at the circulation desk before using the machine.
- ◆ You need to furnish your own paper.
- ◆ Mark the number of dies you use on the card on the table and return dies to rack when finished.

TO USE DIE PRESS

- 1 Raise handle all the way up.
- 2 Place paper against rubber side of die.
- 3 Place die in center of machine, rubber side down.
- 4 Bring the handle over to cut shapes. (May need to press twice.)
CAUTION: Keep a good grip on the handle.
- 5 Remove the die and cut outs.
- 6 Return die to shelf. Please keep dies in alphabetical order.
- 7 Clean up scraps.
